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PREFATORY NOTE.

This Opera is meant to be played, as the original piece should be, in all seriousness. Any attempt to treat it farcically only spoils the humour of the play. As the Overture is represented by that sound which the late Shah of Persia most admired, the tuning of the orchestra, it is as well for the players to practise, as it were, in the hurly-burly, such passages as occur in their parts, a list of which is given in the full score. It must not last long, and the theme of *"Auld Tang syne"* is not to be used here. The few spoken words which the singers have to say will be found in the text book.

The three dialogue parts and the part of Lord Burleigh are intended to be played by actors, not by singers.
