

ges, & que parmy très-peu d'Eloges raisonnables, elle n'ait à en effuyer un grand nombre de mauvais. Lorsqu'un Prince de vostre Rang fait voir un attachement constant pour tous ses devoirs dans un âge ou tout porte à s'en écarter; une discretion si rare dans la jeunesse; une presence d'esprit qui luy fait trouver, sur le champ, mil expédiens dans les embarras où toutes les lumieres des autres se trouvent courtes; un discernement & un bon sens qui pourroient tenir lieu à tout autre d'étude & de scavoir. Quand il est déjà reconnu pour l'ami le plus réel, le plus seur, & le plus fidelle; ayant pour ceux qu'il ayme tout l'empressement des jeunes gens, sans en avoir la legereté; & toute la solidité des personnes avancées en âge, sans en avoir la lenteur; prévenant, sans faire valoir ses services; officieux, sans faire l'important; & ouvert, sans exiger le secret des autres. Lorsqu'il fait paroistre une attention pour ses affaires, également éloigné d'une vigilance trop soupçonneuse & d'une confiance trop négligente; une generosité, une grandeur d'ame, & des sentimens nobles & elevez à travers lesquels on entrevoit déjà, par avance, toute la grandeur de sa Maison se rassembler en luy; une conduite de vie, qui, sans estre ny sévére ny rigide, est neanmoins si exacte & si réguliere; un fond de Religion dont les témoignages éclatans édifient, tous les jours, une Ville Protestant, & donnent aux Dogmes de la foy une force que nulle autre sorte de puissance & d'autorité, que celle de l'exemple, ne scauroient prester à la verité: Permettez-moy de le dire, MONSEIGNEUR, un Prince de ce caractère se trompe, si avec tant de merite il croit échapper aux Panégyristes qui en voyent souvent où il n'y en a point. Il a beau fuir les applaudissemens, sa modestie ne corrigera pas les Autheurs, peuple louangeur, naturellement porté à faire des Eloges & en qui l'on peut dire que le penchant à l'Epitre dédicatoire est une espece de peché originel. Le meilleur party que vous ayez donc à prendre, MONSEIGNEUR, est de vous faire, pour ainsi dire, à la fatigue sur cela. Pour moy j'espere que VOSTRE ALTESSE ne m'en scaura pas mauvais gré si j'ay le premier franchi le pas, n'ayant point d'autre dessein que de luy donner un témoignage de la reconnoissance que j'ay de toutes les bontez qu'elle a pour moy, & de l'entier attachement avec lequel je suis,

Il est permis à Christophe Ballard, seul Imprimeur du Roy pour la Musique, d'Imprimer, faire Imprimer, Vendre & Distribuer toute sorte de Musique, tant Vocale, qu'Instrumentale, de tous Auteurs: Faisant défenses à toutes autres personnes de quelque condition & qualité qu'elles soient, d'entreprendre ou faire entreprendre ladite Impression de Musique, ny autre chose concernant icelle, en aucun lieu de ce Royaume, Terres & Seigneuries de son obéissance, non obstant toutes Lettres à ce contraires; ny mesme de Tailler ny Fondre aucuns Caractères de Musique sans le congé & permission dudit Ballard, à peine de confiscation desdits Caractères & Impressions, & de six mille livres d'amende, ainsi qu'il est plus amplement déclaré esdites Lettres: Sadite Majesté voulant qu'à l'Extrait d'icelles mis au commencement ou fin desdits Livres imprimez, foy soit ajoutée comme à l'Original.
