## PREFACE.

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IN 1894 the late Sir Arthur Sullivan accepted a commission from Sir Henry Irving to compose incidental music to Mr. Comyns Carr's drama of "King Arthur." The work was produced at the Lyceum Theatre, on January 12th, 1895, and proved a great artistic success. After the withdrawal of the drama it was suggested to the composer that it would be a pity to allow such beautiful music to remain unpublished and become forgotten, and that a selection from it might be arranged in the form of a short concert-cantata.

From quite early days, however, Sir Arthur had been fascinated by the story of Arthur and Guinevere and had always desired to write a grand opera on the subject—and indeed at his request the late Mr. Lionel Lewin once sketched out a libretto. Sir Arthur, remaining faithful to the idea of his youth, decided to have no arrangement made of the music in question, because he still hoped some day to compose a grand opera on the subject in which some of this music would of course be incorporated. He so far carried out his scheme as to enter into treaty with Mr. Comyns Carr for the production of a libretto founded on his drama. After the composer's death it was decided to revert to the original proposition regarding the music, and the present concert-arrangement is the result.



