First system of music. The Trumpet in C part is on a single staff in 3/4 time, starting with a first ending bracket over measures 7-8. The Organ part is on a grand staff (treble and bass clefs), providing harmonic support with chords and moving lines. Measure numbers 1 through 8 are indicated at the start of the system.
