Quarter-Tone signs used in this piece :

$\sharp\downarrow$ = 1/4 tone $\flat\downarrow$ = 1/4 tone

$\sharp\uparrow$ = 3/4 tone $\flat\uparrow$ = 3/4 tone

Exampel :
