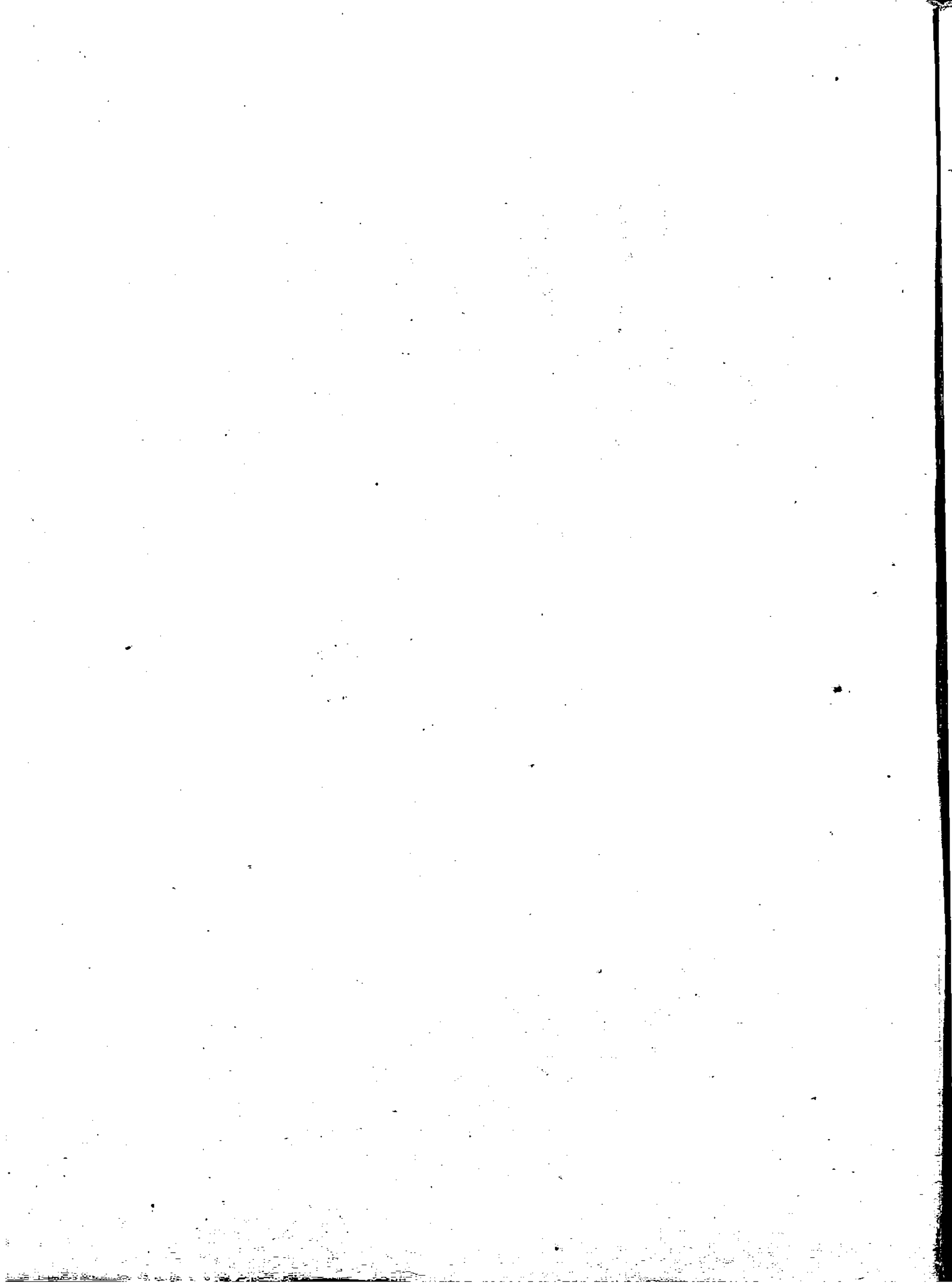

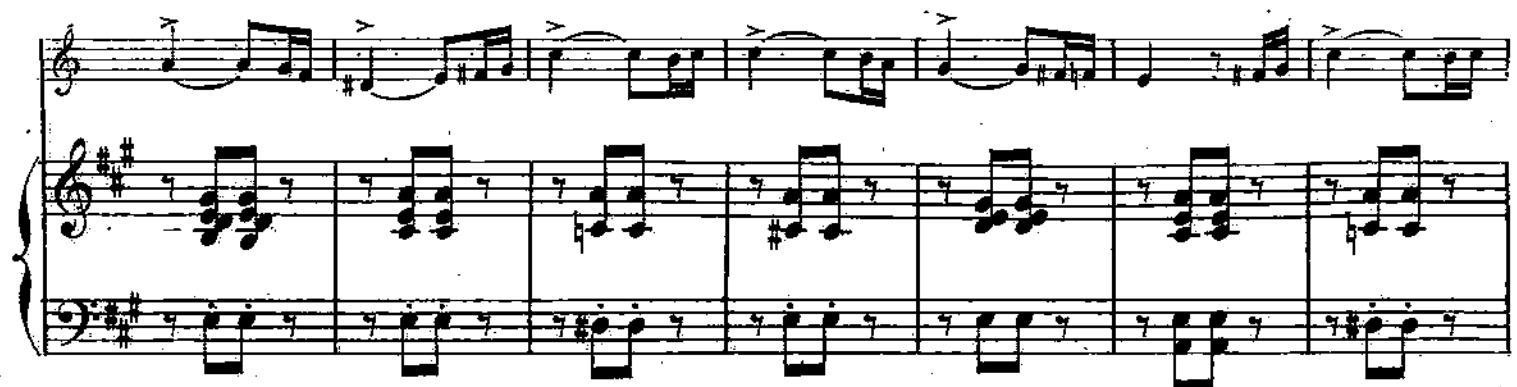

Andantino.

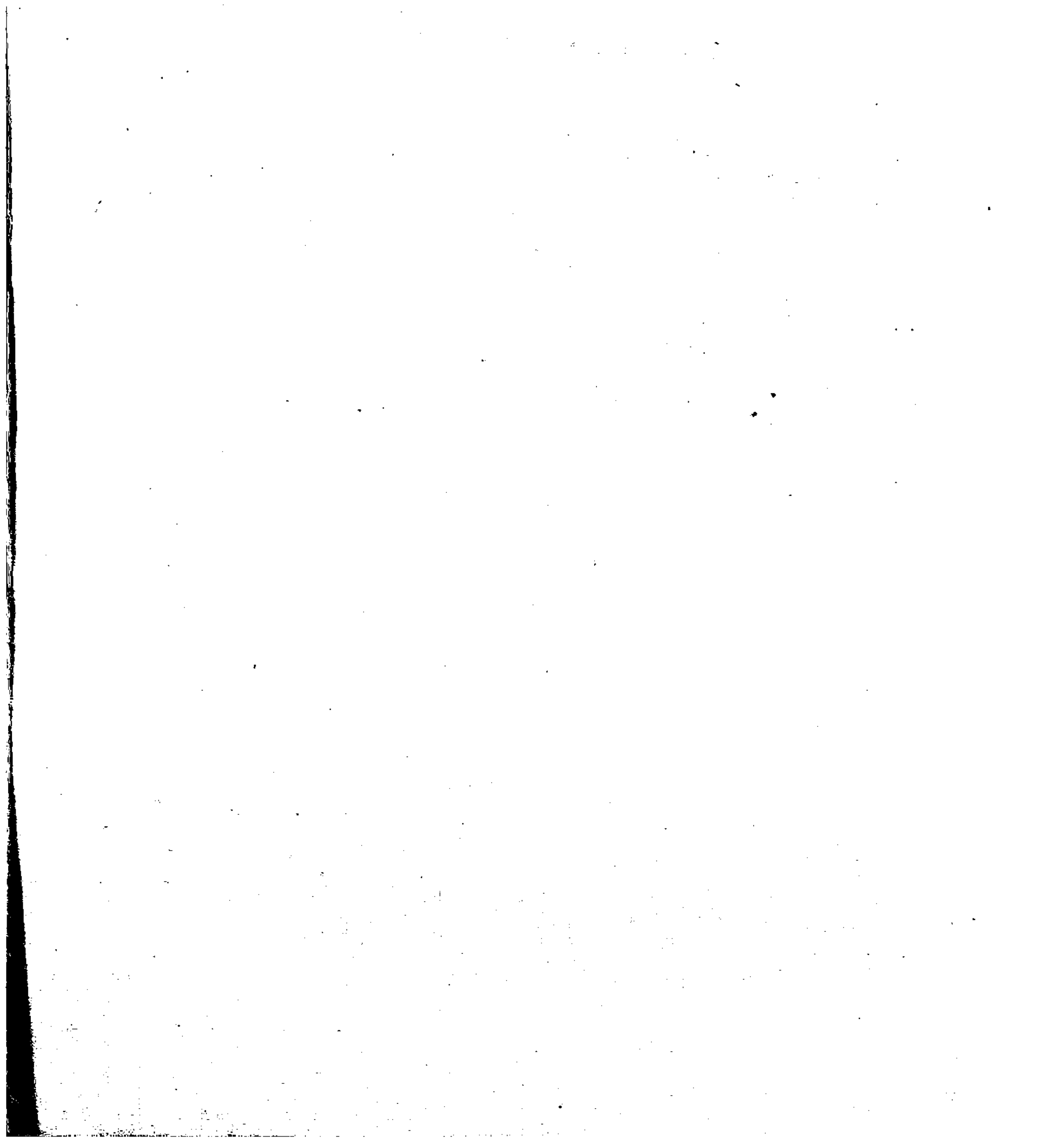
