

## **Program notes for performance with narrator**

In the American lumberjack tradition, there is a genre of folklore called “fearsome critters.” Lumberjacks would sit around the campfire at night and relay stories of these absurd, bizarre, and colorful mythical creatures who lived in the woods. This piece is a musical depiction of several of these critters. The music is inspired by description of these critters in *Fearsome Creatures of the Lumberwoods* by William T. Cox (1910), *Fearsome Critters* by Henry H. Tryon (1939), and *The Wampus Society* (2011)

## **Program notes for performance without narrator**

Out in the woods at night, in the frontier wilderness of North America, lumberjacks told stories of the fantastic and often deadly creatures that they had encountered. The result is a genre of American folklore called “fearsome critters.” Many of these creatures are now extinct, but some may still be found in the wild, so be wary. That strange sound you hear might be the wind . . .

Or it might be a snoligoster . . .

Based on descriptions in *Fearsome Creatures of the Lumberwoods* by William T. Cox (1910), *Fearsome Critters* by Henry H. Tryon (1939), and *The Wampus Society* (2011)

### **1. Night; in the Woods**

### **2. The Hodag (*Deformis corniger lacrimans*)**

The ferocious Hodag has bulging eyes, a maniacal smile, a row of spikes down its back, the head of an ox, the body of a dinosaur, and a shovel-like nose. He feasts upon white bulldogs (but only on Sundays), and he hates when you laugh at him.

### **3. The Hidebehind (*Ursus dissimulans*)**

The only ones to see the grizzly Hidebehind are its victims. Stealthily concealed behind tree trunks, the critter leaps on the unsuspecting lumberjack, disemboweling him with one swipe. The Hidebehind has a severe aversion to alcohol - one good shot of whiskey is a successful repellent.

### **5. The Squonk (*Lacrimacorpus dissolvens*)**

With its misfitting skin covered with warts and moles, the melancholy Squonk may be heard weeping under the boughs of dark hemlock trees on frosty moonlit nights.

### **6. The Goofus Bird (*Fulica stultusregrediens*)**

Frequently heard but seldom seen, this poor creature doesn't care where it's going. Only caring where it's been, it flies backwards. Also known as the Filla-Ma-Loo Bird, it usually builds its nest upside down, and its eggs are invariably Grade D.

### **7. The Snoligoster (*Dorsohastatus caudirostula*)**

The huge snoligoster resembles a crocodile, but it has no legs or fins- just one large spike on its back. Its body is covered with long glossy fur, and it propels itself through the swamp with a propeller-like tail.

### **9. The Whirling Whimpus Meets the Cactus Cat**

At sundown, the Whirling Whimpus (*Turbinocissus nebuloides*) stands by a bend in the trail and whirls on its single hind hoof. It whirls so fast that it becomes invisible, and all you can hear is a strange droning sound. Meanwhile, the Cactus Cat (*Cactifelinus inebrius*) greedily gets drunk on the sap of a giant cactus and runs off howling into the night. Watch out cat! The Whimpus is about to turn you into syrup.



## Note to Conductor

Fearsome Critters is written for one instrument for part. The conductor may double or triple instruments at his/her discretion as long as the sound stays clear and not muddy. Passages marked solo should be played by one instrument.

The work may be performed with or without the narrator part. Program notes are included for both options.

If the piece is performed in its abridged 4-movement version, an alternate p. 28 is included at the end of the score. Alternate parts for the Contrabass and Bass Clarinet can be provided.



# 1. Introduction: Night, in the Woods

Narr: Out in the woods at night, in the frontier wilderness of North America, lumberjacks told stories of the fantastic and often deadly creatures that they had encountered. Many of these creatures are now extinct, but some may still be found in the wild, so be wary. *(pause)*  
That strange sound you hear *might* be the wind . . .

The score is arranged in systems for various instruments. The first system includes Piccolo, Flute 1 & 2, Oboe 1 & 2, English Horn, Bb Clarinet 1-3, Bass Clarinet, Bassoon 1 & 2, Alto Saxophone 1 & 2, Tenor Saxophone, Baritone Saxophone, F Horn 1-4, Bb Trumpet 1-3, Trombone 1-2, Bass Trombone, Euphonium 1 & 2, Tuba, Contrabass, Percussion 1-5, and Piano.

Key performance instructions include:

- Woodwinds:** *pp sempre* for Bassoon 1 & 2; *mf espr.* for F Horn 3; *sfz* for F Horn 1 & 2.
- Brass:** *pp sempre* for Euphonium 1 & 2; *pp sempre* for Tuba; *pp sempre arco* for Contrabass. Trumpets and Trombones have *sfz* markings and "Harmon mute (stem out)" instructions.
- Percussion:** *pp sempre* for Timpani; *pp sempre arco* for Contrabass; *pp* for Bass Drum. Percussion 5 has *enter ad lib. pp* and *mp* markings.
- Piano:** *pp sempre* with "(Ped. freely throughout)".

Additional notes for Percussion 5:

Note: If a large thunder sheet is unavailable or ineffective for a distant thunder sound, a bass drum roll with some soft tam-tam sounds can be used. Perc. 3 may take this part if an additional bass drum is unavailable.

Improvise with "toys" from 5 to m.21 to create creepy night sounds, but don't overdo it! Use instruments that won't interfere with attack of xylophone, such as rainsticks, shakers, and rattles.
