PART I.

Nebuchadnezzar, the king, has made an image of gold; he set it up in the plain of Dura, in the province of Babylon, and commands all the people, nations, and languages to come to the dedication of the image which Nebuchadnezzar, the king, hath set up.

To Him that sitteth on the throne be all honour and glory everlasting ! Hallelujah, Amen.

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
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Plan of the Stage shewing the different positions
