

... my melancholy ..., for Violin and Piano

Introduction

... *my melancholy* ... for Violin and Piano was written between April and May 2001 and received its first performance at the inaugural Finzi New Music Prize, sponsored by the Finzi Trust in June of the same year. The rules of the prize stipulate that the performers for the competition have ideally to be students studying at Reading University. The piece was performed on this occasion by students Phil Searing, (Violin) and Mel Adkins, (Piano), two final year Undergraduates.

The work contrasts percussive with more melodic musical material, the former immediately recognizable at the beginning of the movement (mm. 1-6), the latter heard in the Violin part of the opening section (mm. 7-23). The characteristic repeated figure in the Piano part heard at the beginning becomes the dominant feature of the remaining part of the first section (mm. 25-48). What follows is a highly intense lyrical melodic middle section in which a prominent melodic phrase in the Violin swiftly rises to a dramatic high point (m. 74) followed by an 'aggressive' descent. The dramatic intensity of the middle section is also fuelled by the motor semiquaver figuration prominent in the Piano texture. After a moment of calm in the Piano part (mm. 85-6), there is an immediate return to the material of the opening section, the earlier lyrical melody now treated in a more percussive way.

The short final section (mm. 106-122), functions as a kind of coda, in it we hear the melody of the opening section now much higher in register and more distant sounding, accompanied by quiet alternating figures in the Piano, and ending with short isolated chords.
