νύκτεσ πάρα δ' ἔρχετ' ὥρα,
ἔγω δὲ μόνα κατεύδω.

The sinking moon has left the sky,
The Pleiades have also gone.
Midnight comes - and goes, the hours fly
And solitary still, I lie.

This singularly beautiful fragment is quoted by Hephaestion as an example of metre. With the "Hymn to Aphrodite" it was the first portion of the Poems of Sappho to be printed in 1554.

Sing like a *hush* sound (ʃ)




Pronounce as a harsh “ts” sound
