The double Stops are the Appogiaturas, which, by marking the progression of the Harmony and conjoining with the Melody will produce the Effect of two Instruments.



The HARMONICA _ is a Note produced from another which may be called its Bass_ thus, sound the low C_ blow a little louder and you have its Octave, proceed and you will have G_ double C, E, G, &c. without once moving the Fingers.

The Harmonica at the beginning of the 2^d Prelude is performed in the following manner.
