The solo songs are in the best tradition of the modern English song—faithful to the words in a degree that almost dictates the musical form and yet avoids mere declamation. The junior piano pieces are as simple as they are strikingly musical. And everyone will surely have the *Hiking Tune* running in his head before long!

The composer is also the designer of the cover.
