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Composition Notes

This quintet is intended for 2 Bb Cornets, Eb Alto/Tenor Horn, Euphonium, and Eb Bass Tuba. Parts are available for both T.C. and B.C. Euphonium, and both Eb Bass Tuba in T.C. and Tuba in B.C.

I (the composer) have always loved the sound of conical brass instruments and wanted to provide a chamber piece for these instruments. I have provided XML files and MIDI performance files for each of the three movements. This work is offered in grateful appreciation for God's gift of music.
