Andantino*con espressione*

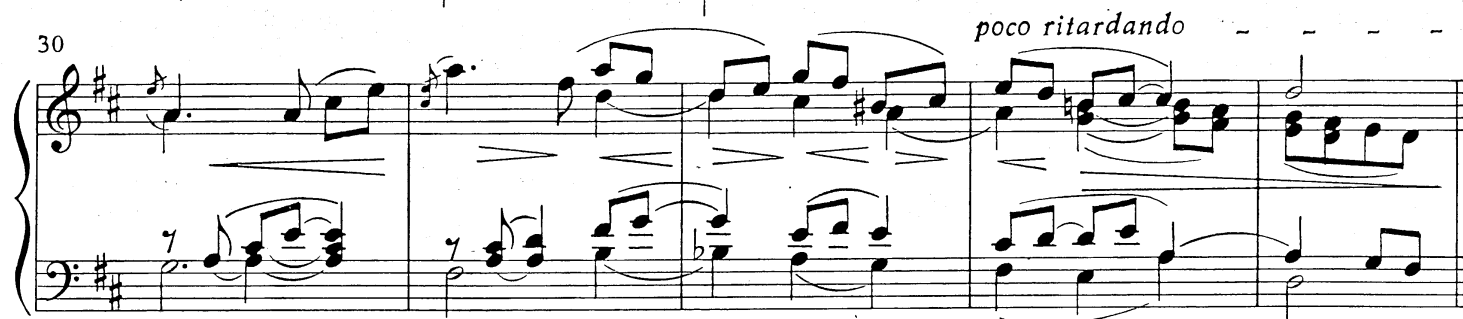
