At the entrance is the site of Ruffin's Ferry, often used by General Washington on his journeys from Mount Vernon to Williamsburg. Unusual chimneys and some original wainscoting. The great fireplace in the kitchen is reported to be one of the largest in Tidewater. Lovely view of river. Mr. and Mrs. Donald W. Vought, owners.
