The editor's intention is to provide a quasimodernised edition, thus retaining the most substantial elements of the original, while at the same time facilitating modern performance. The following is a reference guide to the editorial practices used.

The original manuscript appears to have been annotated in darker and red ink, as well as in pencil; this distinction is not indicated in the present edition, except for ambiguous items, as listed below in the textual notes.

Original clefs (S: C1; A: C3) have been modernised (G2); clef changes in the BC part have been eliminated.

Accidentals are transcribed in compliance with modern notational conventions: original cautionary accidentals are retained, except when they recur within the same measure; editorial accidentals are printed in small type above notes; courtesy accidentals are provided in regular size before notes.

Erroneous or illegible continuo figures are provided within brackets; duplicate continuo entries (above and below staff in different ink) have been conglomerated.

Text repetition indicated in the manuscript by ij as well as incidental corrections are indicated by italic text; the source's overall historical orthography has been retained. Elisions are indicated by silent spaces rather than underties; editorial lyric lines are used when single syllables span unbeamed notes. Presumable missing ties are indicated by dashed ones.

A detailed listing of discrepancies and modifications can be found in the textual notes; any other editorial suggestion is appropriately contained within square brackets, or indicated by *italic* text.
