Flute (Fl) starts with a rest, followed by sixteenth-note patterns at *pp*. Horn (Hb) enters with eighth-note patterns at *pp*. Clarinet (Cl) has eighth-note patterns with dynamics *p*, *pp*, and *fz*. Bassoon (Bn) provides harmonic support with sustained notes and eighth-note patterns at *sf* and *pp*.

C.1-2 (Clarinet/Piccolo) and Trombone (Tb) play eighth-note patterns at *p* and *f*. Clarinet/Piccolo also has a dynamic marking of 1° . Trombone has a dynamic marking of *pp* and *p*.

Triangle/Cymbals (Tri-CC) and Cymbals/Gong (Cy-GC) provide rhythmic patterns throughout the section.

Violin 1 (V1) and Violin 2 (V2) play sixteenth-note patterns at *sf* and *pp*. Alto (A) and Bassoon (Bn) provide harmonic support with sustained notes and eighth-note patterns at *pp*.

Cello (Vc) and Bass (Cb) play eighth-note patterns at *p* and *sf*, followed by sustained notes and eighth-note patterns at *pp*.
