Vivace

- Clarinets in B♭: Rests throughout.
- Bassoons: Rests throughout.
- Horns in F: Rests until measure 5, then play eighth-note patterns.
- Trumpets in B♭: Rests until measure 5, then play eighth-note patterns.
- Trombone: Rests throughout.
- Timpani: Rests until measure 5, then play eighth-note patterns.
- Violins I: Rests throughout.
- Violins II: Rests throughout.
- Violas: Play eighth-note patterns starting in measure 5.
- Violoncellos: Play eighth-note patterns starting in measure 5.
- Contrabasses: Play eighth-note patterns starting in measure 5.

Performance instructions:

- Flutes: Rests throughout.
- Oboes: Rests until measure 5, then play eighth-note patterns.
- Clarinets in B♭: Rests throughout.
- Bassoons: Rests throughout.
- Horns in F: Rests until measure 5, then play eighth-note patterns.
- Trumpets in B♭: Rests until measure 5, then play eighth-note patterns.
- Trombone: Rests throughout.
- Timpani: Rests until measure 5, then play eighth-note patterns.
- Violins I: Rests throughout.
- Violins II: Rests throughout.
- Violas: Play eighth-note patterns starting in measure 5.
- Violoncellos: Play eighth-note patterns starting in measure 5.
- Contrabasses: Play eighth-note patterns starting in measure 5.
