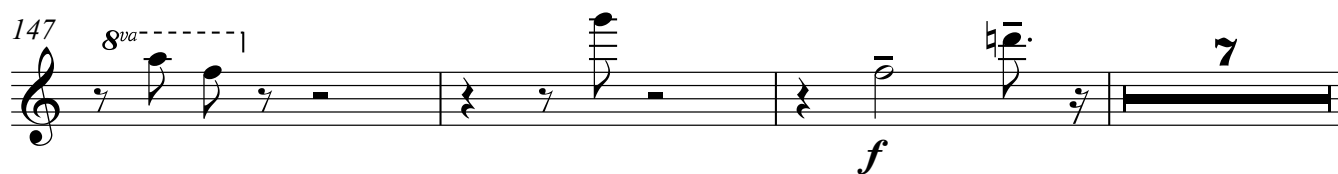
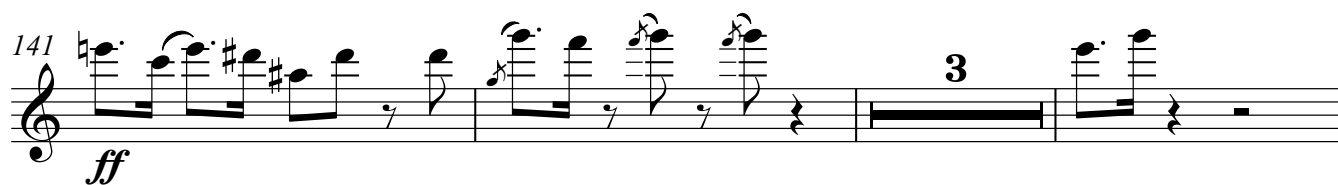
Dance of the Seductress
