General

Beaming and slurs are as the original, albeit some original slurs are ambiguous.

The original's convention regarding accidentals is inconsistent; they mostly persist to the end of the bar, but there are many repeated markings. It has been assumed that accidentals DO persist to the end of the bar, but ignoring the effect of any apoggiatoras. Any exceptions to this assumption are shown as editorial markings above the note. Some redundant accidentals have been retained, as reminders.

Violoncello part

The original is mostly in the tenor clef, but also uses alto, soprano and treble transposed by an octave; the last three have been replaced by treble clef at pitch.

No.2 Allegro, bar 16: the original bar is too long; final note changed from a crotchet to a quaver.

No.4 Allegro moderato, bar 15: the original has a crotchet rest before the repeat and a crotchet E after it; rest changed to a dotted crotchet and the upbeat E to a quaver, as at the beginning and to match the Continuo upbeat.

No.5 Allegro, bars 26 & 57: the original has a minim third note: changed to a crotchet to allow for the following upbeat.

Basso Continuo part

No.2 Allegro, bar 16: as the violoncello part.

No.4 Allegro moderato, bar 5: the third note (G) is a crotchet in the original; changed to a dotted crotchet.

No.5 Allegro, bars 26 & 57: as the violoncello part.

No.6 Tempo di Minuetto: the original Continuo part is shown only for the initial theme statement; a note has been appended suggesting that the part be repeated for Variations 1 to 5.
