RAGLEY PARK.

N^o 2.

Hands four round back again lead down the middle up again and right and left.

N^o 3.

D.C.

First Lady set to the second Gentleman and change places the first Gentleman set to the second Lady and change places swing poussette and right and left.

THE SLAVE.

N^o 4.

Set and half right and left back again lead down the middle up again and turn your partner.

(Clement's Dances, N^o 12.)

ROB ROY.

N^o 5.

D.C.

First Lady falls in between the second and third Gentlemen at the same time the first Gentleman falls in between the second and third Ladies foot it out on oppo. site sides meet again and foot it swing poussette and right and left.

LION HOUSE.

N^o 6.

D.C.

Change sides back again lead down the middle up again add poussette.
