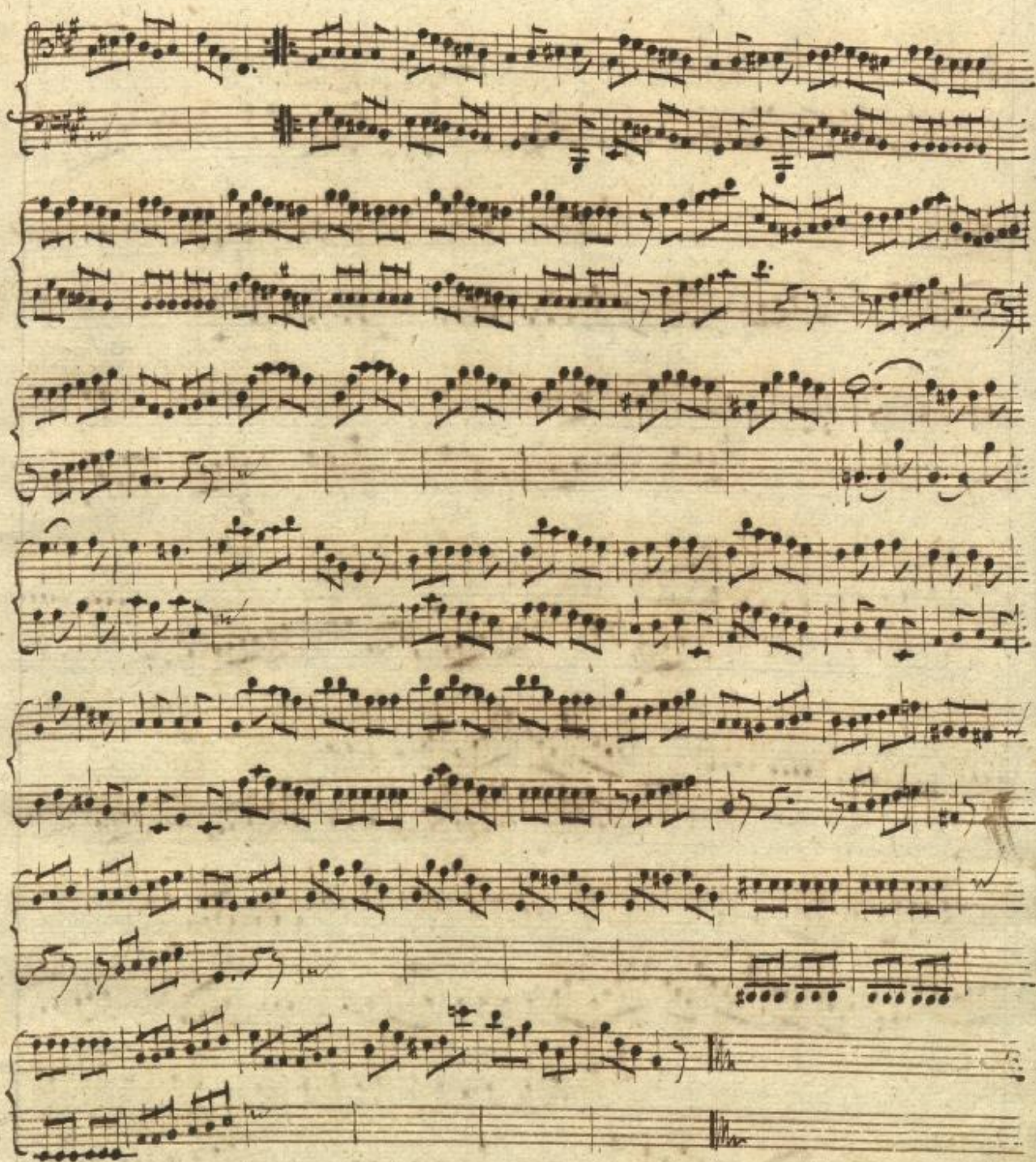


Allegro Inf. Basso. e Viola
