We being willing to give all due Encouragement to Works of this Nature, are graciously pleased to condetcend to his Requeil. And We do therefore by these Prefents fo far as may be agreeable to the Statute in that Behalt made and provided, Grant unto the find Frances Geminiani his Executors, Administrators and Affigns, our Licence for the Sole Printing and Publishing the faid Work, for the Term of Fourteen Years, to be computed from the Date hereof; ftrictly torbidding all our Subjects within our Knadoms and Dominions to reprint or abridge the time, either in the Like or any other Volume or Volumes whattoever; or to import, buy, vend, al er or distribute any Copies thereof reprinted beyond the Seas, during the aforefaid Term of Fourteen Years, without the Content or Aprobation of the laid Francis Geminiani, his Heirs, Executors and Affigns, under their Hands and Seals, first had and obtained, as they will answer the Contrary thereof at their Perils: Likewile the Commissioners and other Officers of the Cuitoms the Master, Warden and Company of Stationers are to take Notice, That due Obedience may be rendered to our Pleasure herein declared. Given at our Court at Kensington, the 29th Day of July, 1739. in the Thirteenth Year of our Reign.
