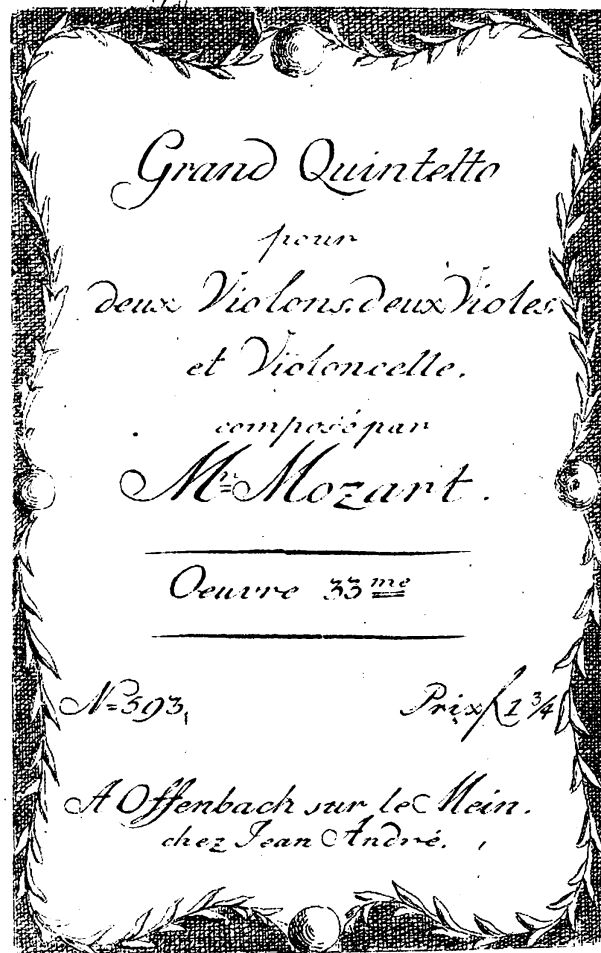

QUINTETTO
